ALERT! Our food supplies are at critical lows and we need your help!

With the recent spikes in food prices, we have more **local households** in crisis requesting help. CRC is in critical need of Non-Perishable Foods in **cans, boxes, bags, squeeze bottles** to meet this demand. Please pack in medium-size boxes or grocery bags that can be safely loaded/unloaded. **Please, no glass** (except jars of baby food).

—**Breakfast Foods:** Cereal (hot or cold), BABY CEREAL (all stages), Milk (evaporated, condensed, powder or sterilized), Juice (plastic bottles, cans, pouches, or cartons) Dried Fruit or Fruit Bars, Jam/Jelly/Preserves, Granola Bars, Cereal Bars, Power Bars, Bisquick or other Pancake/Muffin Mix, Oatmeal, Pancake Syrup, Maple Syrup, Powdered Eggs or egg substitute

—**Cooking Staples:** Salt or salt substitutes, Flour, Granulated Sugar in 1-lb BOXES (please no bags or powdered sugar), Cooking Oil

—**Pasta & Rice:** Mac'n cheese, Ramen; canned pasta (ravioli or SpaghettiOs); rice; pasta;

—**Soups & Sauces:** All kinds of soup and spaghetti sauces

—**Meats & Proteins:** chili or stew; canned meats of all kinds; peanut butter; dry beans

—**Vegetables:** refried beans, pork & beans; corn; peas; beets; carrots

—**Fruit:** apple sauce; raisins; all canned fruit

—**Drinks:** apple or grape juice; powdered milk

(Please, no sodas, tonic water, whole coffee beans, wine or beer; no bottles.)

—**Single Serving/Easy Open Foods:** juice boxes; cheese & crackers; tuna&crackers; tuna in pouches; boxes of chili; cup o' soup
